## Arrival Procedures:

**7:35**~ Students are released from busses and cars to enter the building (no student will be allowed into the building prior to this time)

**7:55** ~ The tardy bell will ring. Students arriving after this time **MUST** be checked into the office by an adult.


All students and drivers are required to wear a mask while utilizing RCPS transportation services.



Masks/face coverings must be worn by all individuals (age 2 and older) who are not fully vaccinated. Those who are fully vaccinated will not be required to wear a mask in most circumstances.

Masks will not be required when learning outside or if students are outside for recess.

The school division will not be conducting daily temperature checks, but we are asking all families to complete health screenings before coming to school each day. If your child is running a fever above 100.4, please keep your child at home. Students must be symptom free of any sickness (vomiting, fever) for 24 hours before returning to school. If your child is not attending school, please contact the office by 9 a.m. to let us know.



Students will be required to maintain 3 feet of physical distance at all times to the greatest extent possible.

At this time parents and volunteers will not be allowed into the building. If there is a meeting scheduled, all individuals who are not vaccinated will be required to wear a mask.

While we are hopeful that COVID-19 transmission rates remain relatively low, please know that all plans are subject to change based upon local transmission rate data and up to date guidance from the Virginia Department of Health (VDH) and CDC.

If needed, individual schools may transition temporarily to fully virtual instruction for a length of time determined in coordination with our local health department. Such a decision would be made in response to case numbers and evidence of transmission at that particular school.

## Dismissal Procedures:

If it is necessary to make a change concerning dismissal, please call the office **by 2:00**. It will be difficult to guarantee changes after this time.

2:55 ~ Students will be dismissed to their busses or move to their pick up location

3:00 ~ Car pick-ups will begin to be called. Please make sure the car pick-up tag is visible on the dash of the car.
